

Tell the Board: **vote no** on Sept 22.

Then finish the plan. Boulder Valley is being asked to close neighborhood elementary schools on page one of a plan no one has completed.

01 The plan isn't finished.

The Board votes Sept 22 on elementary closures while **middle schools, boundaries, dual-language and further consolidations are all still to come.** Families could be moved now and disrupted again later. Kids deserve to see the whole plan first.

02 It doesn't save what it promises.

BVSD's own numbers: **\$3.5–4M a year — under 1% of the budget** — against up to \$10M in building changes plus transition costs. A 2026 Stanford study of California closures found districts essentially broke even. Prove the savings, and compare the alternatives, first.

03 Fewer kids today, but more homes tomorrow.

Boulder just changed its long-term housing plan; **BVSD hasn't rerun the math.** Closing a school is easy. Recreating public-school capacity in Boulder decades from now is not.
